Dr. Valerie Murrah

**Dr. Valerie Murrah** is a Professor and Chair of the UNC Department of Diagnostic Sciences and General Dentistry. She earned her DMD from Southern Illinois University and her MS in Oral Pathology from the University of Minnesota. Her research focuses on tobacco and viral co-factors in oral carcinogenesis and aspects of gene therapy for oral cancer.



Dr. Tim Wright

**Dr. Tim Wright** is the Chair of the UNC Department of Pediatric Dentistry. Dr. Wright is a dental graduate of West Virginia University School of Dentistry and completed his pediatric dentistry specialty training and a genetics fellowship at the University of Alabama-Birmingham. He has extensive research and clinical experience in the diagnosis and treatment of oral pathology with an emphasis on dental and osseous craniofacial structures.

# Objectives: Provide

1. An overview of oral lesions that you may encounter while caring for children.
2. Techniques for the management of patients with the more common lesions, discuss pitfalls to avoid, and recommend strategies for educating patients and their parents about the conditions.
3. Specific oral entities will be discussed that may reflect underlying systemic disease.
4. The diverse mechanisms that lead to development defects of the craniofacial hard tissues and how understanding of the specific tissue defect is critical for both the diagnosis and treatment of these pathological conditions.
5. An objective framework and approach for diagnosing defects that affect the dentition and delineating the environmental and heredity etiologies of these diverse clinical conditions.
6. A variety of practical approaches to treating developmental defects of the human dentition and shed light on future potential treatment approaches including tooth regeneration.
